**EXPRESSING CONTINUED SUPPORT FOR THE  
ADIRONDACK PARK LOCAL GOVERNMENT REVIEW BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, the Adirondack Park Local Government Review Board is established under the same law as the Adirondack Park Agency with the statutory mission to advise and assist the agency in carrying out its functions, powers, and duties, and

**WHEREAS**, the Adirondack Park Local Government Review Board is composed of representatives from each of the counties inside the park boundaries and is required to submit to the New York State Governor an annual report addressing the concerns of the local government as it relates to the Adirondack Park, and

**WHEREAS**, the level of support for the Adirondack Park Local Government Review Board has been questioned and the suggestion has been made that they are not representing the local governments of the Adirondack Park, and

**WHEREAS**, the issues set forth in the Adirondack Park Local Government Review Board's Annual Report to the Governor are indeed issues that have been raised repeatedly by local governments, and

**WHEREAS**, the ongoing efforts to question the role of the Adirondack Park Local Government Review Board on issues of planning and local concern specific to State land acquisition are deeply troubling in that the Adirondack Park Agency Act clearly details such functions as a role for the Adirondack Park Agency and, therefore, for the Adirondack Park Local Government Review Board, and

**WHEREAS**, the St. Lawrence County Board of Legislators has determined that it is imperative to set the record straight,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Legislators expresses their continued support for the Adirondack Park Local Government Review Board, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution be forwarded to Governor David Paterson, Senators Charles Schumer and Kirsten Gillibrand, Assemblywomen Dierdre Scozzafava and Addie Russell, Senators Darrel Aubertine and Joseph Griffo, DEC Commissioner Alexander Grannis, Adirondack Park Agency Chairman Curt Stiles, and the Adirondack Association of Towns and Villages.
